The class is limited to 45 participants and will be given on a first-come, first-serve basis. No registrations or payments will be accepted during the start of class.
Upon successful completion of this course, students will be required to apply to the State o Wyoming Professional Teaching Standards Board (PTSB) for the certification. PTSB will require applicants to pay a \$100 application fee.

# Substitute Teaching Permit Requirements of The State of Wyoming Professional Teaching Standards Board

There are two ways to **meet the requirements** for a substitute teacher permit.

### **College Credit Path**

- Complete at least 60 semester hours from a regionally accredited college/university
- Successfully complete the US and Wyoming Constitution exams
- Submit fingerprints and received a clear background check
- Submit a complete application packet for a Wyoming Educator Permit

#### **Alternative Path**

- Hold a high school diploma or GED
- Complete at least 24 hours of school district in-service training
- Complete at least 30 hours of classroom observation (10 hours must be completed at EACH level: elementary, junior high/middle, and high school.)
  - To obtain a Substitute Observation Hours Records Sheet (visit FC BOCES or download at this site.)
- Successfully complete the US and Wyoming Constitution exams
- Submit a complete application packet for a Wyoming Educator Permit
